## **Removal of £10 minimum personal contribution**

People who plan on using their ILA Scotland learner accounts to help pay for learning received a boost this month.

Previously, learners had to contribute a minimum of £10 towards the cost of their courses when using their ILA Scotland funding. This is no longer the case thanks to a change of Scottish Government regulations which came into effect on 1st January 2009.

It's hoped that by removing the minimum payment, more people will sign up for an ILA Scotland account and get involved in learning.

We were able to implement the removal of this requirement early and as such, any bookings made on or after Wednesday 17th December 2008 will no longer require a minimum personal contribution of £10 from the learner.
