



## **ILA Scotland eligibility**

ILA Scotland is a grant to increase participation in adult learning and is awarded based upon on an individual's personal circumstances.

To be eligible for ILA Scotland funding learners must:

- be aged 16 or over and
- have an income of £22,000 a year, or less or be on benefits
- be ordinarily resident in Scotland.

ILA Scotland is targeted to individuals who have an annual income of £22,000 a year or less. Those who are in receipt of benefits or tax credits are also eligible for ILA Scotland funding, although in some cases fee waiver may be more appropriate.

Funding of up to £200 is available to learners who are interested in learning something new or brushing up on their skills. There is a wide range of courses available and learners can study with any learning provider who is approved by ILA Scotland including colleges, universities, private training companies, and learning centres.
