This Higher National Certificate course aims to develop learners' knowledge and understanding of the care and education of young children.

The course includes subjects such as child protection, curriculum and assessment approaches, family issues, how children develop and learn as well as workplace practical experience.

Entry requirements for this course are two Highers, or the SVQ Level 2 Early years Care and Education or relevant experience.

This year-long course is available at Paisley's Reid Kerr College in the science, sport health and care department.
